

The Charles Causley Trust Young Person's Poetry Competition 2026



- 1. The Charles Causley Young Person's Poetry Competition 2026 is free to enter and open to all young people **aged between 5 and 18 years old who live in the UK.**
- 2. Your poem must be written in English and be related to the theme of 'Family'.
- 3. The competition closes at midnight (UK time) on **Sunday 4thJanuary 2026**.
- 4. There will be 3 prizes awarded for each age category each receiving a book token and a copy of a Charles Causley poetry book. The winners of the 16-18 year old category will also receive a Launceston Poetry Festival pass, giving them free access to all events. There will also be a prize for the best poem from a young person based in Cornwall.
- Winners will be notified in March 2026 and invited to an award ceremony at the Launceston Poetry Festival on Friday 1st May, where winners will be able to read their successful poems.
- 6. The age categories are: 5 10, 11 15 and 16 18.
- 7. There is no limit to the number of entries you can make.
- 8. Your poem should be up to **40 lines long**. The title and lines between verses aren't included in the 40-line limit.
